

University Health

- A separate political subdivision of the State of Texas proudly owned by the people of Bexar County, with roots that go back to 1917.
 - About 9,000 employees. 1,000 physicians. 700 resident physicians
 - Health System budget for 2021: \$2.1 Billion
- Bexar County Commissioners Court
 - Appoints Bexar County Hospital District Board of Managers
 - Sets the Annual Hospital District tax rate
 - Approves the annual capital and operations budgets.
- Less than 22% of revenue comes from local property taxes.
- Partnered with University of Texas Health Science Center San Antonio
 - South Texas' first Nurse Magnet health system (2010 & 2015)
 - Level I Trauma Center for 22 counties
 - Comprehensive Stroke Center
 - Center for Organ Transplantation
 - Level IV Neonatal & Maternal Center
 - Level IV Epilepsy Center
 - Adult & Pediatric Cancer Centers

Non-Competitive Solicitations

- Non-Competitive Solicitations (\$0-\$10,000)
 - At least 1 quote must be obtained
 - Vendors can be identified by the requesting department
 - Bids submitted via email or Phone
 - Vendors registered on the B2G system with appropriate codes are contacted
 - SMWBVE solicitation and response is tracked



Informal Solicitations

- Informal Solicitations (\$10,000-\$50,000)
 - At least 3 Quotes must be obtained
 - Bids submitted via email only
 - Vendors can be identified by the requesting department
 - Vendors registered on the B2G system with appropriate codes are contacted
 - SMWBVE solicitation and response is tracked



Formal Solicitations

- Formal Solicitations (over \$50,000)
 - Respondents must submit (mail or hand delivered) formal paper bid according to the specifications and standard purchasing terms and conditions to:
 - University Health Business Center Procurement Services Department 5800 Farinon Dr. BC-1 San Antonio, Texas, 78249
 - Please reference solicitation number on the package
 - Responses must be received as described in the solicitation documents and before the due date and time listed
 - Some solicitations may require a mandatory pre-proposal conference
 - Vendors registered on the B2G system with appropriate codes are contacted
 - SMWBVE solicitation and response is tracked







